## New IRS Scam: IRS CP 2000 Form

There is a new IRS scam going around recently. In this case you are sent a phony IRS CP 2000 form and claim the income reported on your tax return does not match the income reported by your employer. This is meant to get you worried. To confuse you further, they will claim this has something to do with the Affordable Care Act.

You might receive emails with attached phony forms, text messages and even live calls to your phone about this. The IRS will never initiate contact with you to collect overdue taxes by an email, text message or phone call. If you get any emails, text messages, live calls, or even postal mail about this, do not respond. If you receive a "CP 2000" form in the mail and doubt it is legitimate, you can always call the IRS at 1-800-366-4484 to confirm it is a scam.
